The new Camp Greenwood Challenge Course!

The new course is made possible by a grant from Capsugel and Pfizer.

The fifty foot tall Alpine Tower takes center stage in the course. There are multiple routes to get to the top that will challenge even the most experienced climbers! All levels of climbers can do it. If you can safely wear a harness, you go learn to step out of your comfort zone and come away feeling great about yourself! Climbers can face variety of initiatives during the ascent route. This tower design includes universal access of all persons, including persons with disabilities.

The team development course is a ground level challenge that will also be constructed and it will be a prelude to the Alpine Tower.

And for all of you swingers out there, the giant swing awaits you mid-way between the top of the Alpine Tower and another 50 foot high pole. You are in control of how much “Swing” you want as we pull you from a stop position back toward the tower.

Opening this spring, the Challenge Course is great for youth programs, corporate training programs and outdoor adventure programs. Between 8-36 participants can be involved at one time on the tower. The Team Development Course has more than 40 activities that can be performed. The course will be located in our day camp area behind the track field. Construction was set to begin tomorrow but the rains have probably delayed that. Once the tower is up, you’ll know as it will be seen from the road as you pass by the Y fields.
